Appointed by the village board as per state statutes
Has exclusive control of the expenditure of all moneys collected, donated, or appropriated for the library fund
Supervises the administration of the public library and hires a library director

Reports to the library board
Manages the daily operations of the library
Represents the library on SCLS and DCLS committees/meetings
Represents the library at LINK meetings

Manages the public service desk

SHELVERS

Dane County Library Service (DCLS):
Plans library services for those residents without municipal library service
Determines minimum standards of operation for public libraries in the county
Reimburses county libraries at 70% (minimum) of their cost to provide library services to county residents

Department of Public Instruction (DPI):
Sets standards for the development and operation of library systems
Allocates system funding
Sets standards for the county library service
Sets standards for municipal library service

South Central Library System (SCLS):
Monitors the ability of the libraries within its borders to maintain DPI standards for library service
Monitors municipal funding levels for libraries within its borders
Provides cooperative services through a team of consultants who assist with marketing, collection development, continuing education, etc.
