• Request for Proposal (RFP) re: Interior Upgrade Projects

Discussion of RFP sections:

Items to be included in RFP-concerns that will not be able to upgrade all of the public bathrooms and add the additional exterior exit for the budget available. Additional exit will be removed from the RFP and updating the staff bathroom was included. Also, under soft costs on p. 7 of RFP, remove everything after "asbestos"

insurance requirements- just list types of coverage required in the general paragraph, not specifically listed below as in the draft

timeline- RFP will be sent out today, Post on Village web site, check with Jeff Gorman to see if he has suggestions for architects; Proposals due on May 22, open bids with 1 or 2 Board members present, next Library Board meeting May 28-select top 3, start interviews week of June 1, hold Special Board meeting the week of June 1st to act on Architect selection

- Safer at Home Executive Order #28 update-reviewed lawsuit status against the extension of Safer at Home and our views on re-opening the Library, Williams is adding clerks to do pick list from 5-7, will offer drive-ups until 7 pm
- Delivery from inter-library loan will start up again, some pushback from staff about patrons returning books and concerns about safety, Williams will check with other Libraries and Dane County Public Health for recommended practices
